### Vendor Info Session

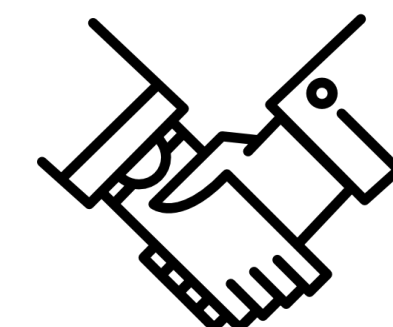
Mandatory for all sponsors along with their sponsored vendors.

# Sponsor FAQ



## Who is a Sponsor?

- One person/family who will take responsibility to intentionally build relationship with a vendor for the purpose of evangelism.
- Must be a baptized member of CCAC.
- A person/family who will set up a table to sell goods at the event alongside their sponsored vendor in order to have a shared experience.

## Who is a Vendor?

- One person/family who would be selling their own goods at our event.
- Someone who is not a Christian and needs to be evangelized.
- A person/family invited by a sponsor to participate at our event.
- Someone who you as a sponsor want to evangelize.

## Why should you become a Sponsor?

- To share Christ with your friends/family who do not know him.
- To build relationship with someone who does not know Christ.
- To expand our church's reach and visibility in the community.
- To make disciples of all nations.

## What are the responsibilities of a Sponsor?

- To invite one person/family to come be a vendor at our event.
- To love thy neighbour; to get to know your vendor before the event through coffee/meals, to have conversations and to help them set up and clean up on the day of the event.
